In an effort to improve conditions for walkers, joggers, bikers, and wheelchair users in our area, Clackamas County Parks and North Clackamas Parks and Recreation District, along with 6 other local governments, are taking part in a national weeklong effort to count and survey trail and bike lane users. This marks the third time Clackamas County will participate in this nationwide effort!

One of the greatest challenges facing the bicycle and pedestrian field is the lack of documentation on usage and demand. Without accurate and consistent demand and usage figures, it is difficult to measure the positive benefits of investments in these modes of transportation. The National Bicycle & Pedestrian Documentation Project provides a consistent model of data collection and ongoing data for use by planners, governments, and bicycle and pedestrian professionals.
